

# Seat Fillers

## To determine the Logic Puzzle of the Year - Presented by Banterweight & Tablesaw

During a ceremony as long and swanky as the Sphinxies, the celebs inevitably need to take a break; fortunately there's an elite corps of seat fillers ready to take their places. There are currently 27 fillers in the audience: 9 in the left section, 9 in the center, and 9 in the right.

Numbers in the seats represent celebrities complaining about the proximal "normal" people; they indicate how many of the adjacent seats (including diagonally adjacent, but not across the aisle) contain fillers. Numbered seats do not contain fillers.

Numbers in the aisles represent ushers keeping watch; they indicate how many of the eleven seats in the rows to their left and right (but not past the other aisle) contain fillers.

If you'd like to note where the fillers are seated, an additional seating chart is provided.
