

WINNER! - Word Search of the Year Cold Case

Thanks to the reopening of a number of cold cases, 23 criminals and one pair of criminals, real and fictional, have recently been imprisoned in the 6-by-8 jail cells below. (And let's just pretend the pair of criminals is a single criminal for the sake of making the rest of these instructions less convoluted, shall we?) Each cell contains two criminals and their crimes; the name of each criminal followed by their crime can be read by moving from letter to adjacent letter up, down, left, or right, but not diagonally. For example, in the solitary confinement cell below, one can trace out the phrase "SOCRATES—IMPIETY." (As you can see, many of these crimes are very serious.) No letter in the grid is used twice in the same path.
